## ABOUT WOMEN RESOURCE CENTRE

Women encounter challenges like limited access to for education, healthcare, and economic opportunities. While there are programs for empowerment, a lack of information and accessibility impedes their participation. To address this, a resource center by Seba Jagat for women is being planned to bridge the information gap.

### OBJECTIVE 1

Enhance their access to information regarding land and livelihood opportunities, governmental schemes, educational programs, and healthcare services

### OBJECTIVE 2

Serve as a platform for advocacy on issues affecting tribal women, promoting their rights and welfare

### ACTIVITIES

1. Information Dissemination: Provide up-to-date information on schemes, grants, and programs available for tribal women's economic empowerment and welfare.

### ACTIVITIES

2. Skills Training: Conduct training sessions in traditional and new livelihood skills, including agriculture, digital literacy, entrepreneurship, strengthening tradition forest management and knowledge of entitlements

### ACTIVITIES

3. Education and Networking: Educate women on land literacy and financial management, assisting them in accessing livelihood entitlements, fostering network for sharing experiences and advocating for their rights.
